ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Registration limited to **public libraries only**. Please do not register if your library is part of the Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP)*. Registration is subject to review to ensure eligibility.
- ▶ If eligible, registrants will receive a copy of the *Toolkit* on a first come, first served basis.
- ▶ Resources are limited. Registrants will receive one *Toolkit* at no charge. Additional copies may be purchased through the Government Printing Office (GPO) in the future.
- ▶ Registration begins June 2007 and will remain open while supplies last.

*The *Civics and Citizenship Toolkit* will be distributed automatically to the network of libraries in the Federal Depository Library Program (FDLP).
