- 2. How might we utilize existing free/low-cost resources to promote the Census leading up to 2020/encourage response for 2020?
- 3. How might we communicate to the public the importance of the Census? (As it relates to grants, public programs, apportionment, appropriation, etc...)
- 4. How might we make the Census a FUN event in our communities?
