
Overview - number of staff furloughed and/or laid off


- 25 library systems (52%) have had to reduce staff



Combined layoff and furlough data






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
Budget Impact

91% of respondents report budget for remainder of FY20 was not affected




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22% of respondents anticipate budget reduction for FY21




Services Impact

98% of respondents are providing virtual programming




78% of respondents are emptying their bookdrop at least once per week



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

eZone Checkouts




Peak use: eZone checkouts 52% higher week of April 18

EZone checkouts 43% higher week of May 2


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Content downloaded from eZone consists primarily of ebooks, but also includes audiobooks and streaming video.
