Angleberger, Tom. *The Strange Case of Origami Yoda* Grades 5- 6  
Is Origami Yoda real? Or is it just Dwight who is answering everyone's questions with his Origami Yoda? Tommy enlists the help of his classmates, gathering stories and sketches to find out the truth. Tommy needs to know if Origami Yoda is real because he needs to know if he can trust him with a very important question...

Baskin, Nora Raleigh. *Anything But Typical* Grades 5- 6  
Jason is a boy with autism. Kids at school think he is "weird" and usually avoid him. Jason finally finds friendship with a girl in his online writing group. Will a face-to-face meeting change their friendship?

DiCamillo, Kate. *Bink and Gollie* Grades 3-4  
Bink & Gollie, two imaginative best friends, share a tree house and a love of pancakes. In three very funny adventures, without leaving their neighborhood, they climb the Andes, befriend a goldfish, and have a big fight about rainbow colored socks.

Fleming, Candace. *Fabled Fifth Graders of Aesop Elementary School* Grades 4- 6  
When Mr. Jupiter's class starts fifth grade, the students and their teacher arrive wearing identical toucan headdresses. The moral of the story: Birds of a feather flock together. Mr. Jupiter and his class spend the school year together: learning, and having fun with lessons like singing hamsters and George Washington's teeth.

Holm, Jennifer L. *Turtle in Paradise* Grades 4- 6  
It's 1935 and 11-year-old Turtle moves to Key West to live with her Aunt Minnie. Her Mom is a live-in housekeeper, and her new employer doesn't want children around. Key West turns out to be fascinating, complete with a Diaper Gang, hidden pirates' treasures, and first cousins named Beans, Buddy, and Kermit.

Lord Cynthia. *Touch Blue* Grades 4- 6  
"Touch Blue and your wish will come true." When the state of Maine plans to shut down her island's schoolhouse, Tess's family may be forced to move to the mainland. Will her luck hold out and her wish come true?

Macy, Sue. *Bylines: A Photobiography of Nellie Bly* Grades 4-6  
Daring news reporter, globetrotter, and advocate for women's rights, Nellie Bly made people stand up and take notice.

McCarthy, Meghan. *Pop :The Invention of Bubble Gum* Grades 3- 5  
Accidents can sometimes be fun! The true story of how an accountant at a candy company, who likes a good puzzle, stumbles upon the perfect recipe for bubble gum.

Mone, Gregory. *Fish* Grades 4- 6  
Get ready for a swashbuckling pirate adventure! Join Fish as he swabs the decks on the *Scurvy Mistress*. When Fish finds himself

caught between the noble Captain Cobb and the deceitful first-mate Scab, he puts his clever nature to good use. A story of mutiny, sea battles and of course, hidden treasure!

Naylor, Phyllis Reynolds. *Emily's Fortune* Grades 3- 6  
Eight year old Emily sets off on a rip-roarin' ride as she travels by stagecoach in a Wild West adventure. She teams up with a boy named Jackson to outsmart her wicked uncle who wants her **fortune**.

Nelson, Vaunda Micheaux. *Bad News for Outlaws: The Remarkable Life of Bass Reeves, Deputy U.S. Marshal* Grades 3- 6  
It is 1875 and the West needs deputies. Former slave, Bass Reeves is hired to keep the peace. He is an honest man with a strong sense of right and wrong. Through courage and expert marksmanship Deputy Reeves brings 3,000 criminals to justice.

Paulsen, Gary. *Masters of Disaster* Grades 4- 6  
Henry and best friends, Riley and Reed share wacky and daring adventures. "Call 9-1-1" as these friends jump off a roof on a bicycle try to break a world record, spend the night in the woods with wild animals, and attempt to solve a hundred year old murder mystery.

Polacco, Patricia. *Junkyard Wonders* Grades 3- 5  
Young Trish finds herself welcomed into the "junkyard", a class of very special friends, led by a very special teacher, who all learn to fly as they overcome tragedy and trials to triumph together!

Roberts, Laura Peyton. *Green* Grades 4- 6  
Lilybet Green's 13th birthday begins with a bang. Literally! An exploding present is the start of a colorful adventure. Kidnapped by a trio of leprechauns, Lily is next in line to be Keeper for the Clan of Green's gold – but only if she passes three tests that could change her life forever!

Singer, Marilyn. *Mirror, Mirror: A Book of Reversible Verse* Grades 3- 6

Stauffacher, Sue. *Gator on the Loose!* Grades 3- 5  
Carter's *Urban Rescue* is the place to call when you find a wild animal where it shouldn't be. Especially, when it's a baby alligator - loose at the city pool! Follow the fun and adventures of this delightful family who work together to get the job done.

Viorst, Judith. *Lulu and the Brontosaurus* Grades 3- 4  
Bossy! Demanding! Spoiled! That's Lulu! Is it possible for a polite brontosaurus to be the pet she wants for her birthday? Or will Lulu find she has met her match and finally change her ways?

Williams-Garcia, Rita. *One Crazy Summer* Grades 5- 6  
As they board a plane to visit their mother in California, Delphine and her sisters imagine themselves visiting Disneyland, and meeting movie stars. Instead they learn about the Black Panthers, and a mother who's a mystery to them.
